The Writers' Room is a working and meeting space made available to Wild Pansy Press (WPP) by The Florence Trust http://www.theflorencetrust.com/ It is part of their new studio space and gallery development in the former Holy Trinity Church building in Cloudesley Square, Islington.

The space is approximately 15m² with its own separate access via the church grounds. It is at present simply furnished with adaptable desking, shelves and lighting all of which can be removed and stored if necessary. There is a projector with a fixed mount, a sink and a small toilet/shower by the entrance (see plan and photos below). Users can work directly on the walls as long as all are repainted for the next user/s – we have huge vats of white emulsion easily to hand! The building has full WiFi coverage with a fast broadband connection.

Access for keyholders is 24/7 and includes access to the larger kitchen and meeting area in the main Florence Trust studios area accessed by the main building entrance. From April there will be public access to the grounds of the building Thursday to Sunday afternoons (TBC) and access by arrangement at other times (with a bell on the West gate of the building).

Please note, the Writers' Room is run and staffed on an entirely voluntary basis, as is the Wild Pansy Press. We are all happy to do this but it means that we may not be able to respond to proposals and questions as quickly as we would like.

For artists undertaking residencies, we will always try and deal with any practical issues or requests as quickly and efficiently as we can. What funding we receive is generally taken up by running costs, but we are constantly looking for sources of support, financially and in kind.
